Yuma's Education Scholarship Fund for Kids, Inc. (**Yes!** Fund for Kids) is a School Tuition Organization in accordance with the provisions of A.R.S. 43-1089. It was incorporated in 2003 for the purpose of implementing the Arizona Private School Tuition Tax Credit and is a tax-exempt charitable organization pursuant to section 501C(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

How The Tax Credit Program Works For Kids

The Arizona Private School Tuition Tax Credit law, A.R.S. Section 43-1089, allows Arizona taxpayers to make donations each year to Yuma's Education Scholarship Fund for Kids, Inc. (**Yes!** Fund for Kids).

A married couple filing jointly can make a donation up to \$1,000 and a single taxpayer's donation can be up to \$500. The taxpayer will receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit against their Arizona state income tax. If the taxpayer has actual Arizona state income tax less than the allowable credit, the law allows a carryover of any unused donation for up to five years.

A taxpayer may also be able to claim a federal deduction for the donation. The taxpayer should consult their tax advisor for specific tax advice.

Yes! Purpose

The **Yes!** Fund for Kids is dedicated to increasing the opportunities for children to receive a Christian education through the efficient implementation of the provisions of the Arizona Private School Tuition Tax Credit.

What You Can Do

- ☺ Complete a **Yes!** Donation Card and send a check for up to \$1,000 to the Yuma Education Scholarship Fund for Kids, Inc. (**Yes!** Fund for Kids). The address is 4027 S Navel Avenue, Yuma, AZ 85365. Donations made by April 15 may be applied to either the current or preceding taxable year and will be considered to have been made on the last day of that taxable year.
- ☺ You will receive a tax receipt for your donation by mail.
- ☺ Complete forms 301 and 323 and attach to your Arizona state income tax return.
- ☺ You can also receive the tax credit for the public school extra-curricular activities donation of \$400 (for married taxpayers) or \$200 (for a single taxpayer).

Donation Card

Donations will be used for tuition grants for K-12 students attending private schools in Arizona. Tuition grant/scholarships will be awarded without regard to the student's race, color, handicap, familial status or national origin. At least ninety percent of the donated funds received will be used for tuition grant/scholarships. Admission decisions are the exclusive responsibility of the school. The maximum Arizona state income tax credit is \$1,000 for married persons filing jointly or \$500 for a single taxpayer, or the actual tax, whichever is less. These donations are pursuant to A.R.S. Section 43-1089. Donations made by April 15 may be applied to either the current or preceding taxable year and will be considered to have been made on the last day of that taxable year. The **YES!** Fund for Kids, Inc. has complete discretion regarding grant/scholarship awards.
